As you may be aware of, the California GIS Council (CGC) has created a Regional Subcommittee “to develop a Regional GIS Council structure to provide input into the Council’s planning, policy development, and project partnerships.” This Subcommittee has solicited input on the definition of regional operational areas from GIS stakeholders. In response, a team of Regional GIS professionals developed recommendations for forming a Bay Area Regional (BAR) GIS Council.

The Bay Area Regional (BAR) GIS Council was presented to the Regional GIS Coordinator, Ron Brummell, the State Geographic Information Officer, Gary Darling, and the California GIS Council at the State Council meeting on March 6, 2002.
